

## **QUICK TIRE CARE CHECKLIST**

## **6 Simple Steps for Pre-Departure Inspection**

|   | (Night before departure) Plug in TST Tire Pressure Monitoring     System to top up its charge.   |
|   |  |
|   | 2. (Morning of departure) Turn on TST - allow 5 minutes for sensors to update.   |
|   | 3. Visually inspect tires for damage or wear. Look for -   |
|   | Cracks   |
|   | Uneven tread wear  |
|   | Embedded nails, screws, etc.   |
|   | 4. Verify that you've got tire tools in the Airstream. These include -   |
|   | Complete Tire Changing Kit   |
|   | Portable air compressor and extension cord   |
|   | Levelling blocks   |
|   | 5. Check tire pressures on TST.  |
|   | Top up any tires to "MAX PSI COLD" as indicated on the sidewall of the tires   |
|   | <ul> <li>Check tire pressure on the spare tire, with a gauge (if it's not<br/>equipped with a TST sensor)</li> </ul>                       |
|   | 6. If any wheels have been removed in the last 100 miles, check lug nut torque with the torque wrench (included in the Tire Changing Kit). |
